# COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

This is an evolving real-time situation, so it is important to understand the most up to date advice. The Parish Council encourages everyone to follow the advice from the NHS daily updates which can be found on their website: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/.

The Parish Council have taken the decision to close its office to the public from 18th March. This is to protect its staff and members of the public. In line with Government advice, our play areas at Norman Road and Arnold Recreation Ground including the fitness equipment are currently closed.

As a community, we will all be aware of neighbours, friends and family members who may be vulnerable and at risk, as well as lonely. Please consider the following to help:

- Follow the advice. Although the measures being introduced may seem restrictive, it is important to follow the national advice. If you feel ill, visit the website above and go from there.

- Pick up the phone. A daily check on people can not only help with ensuring safety and if necessary medical intervention, it can be a real boost for mental health. As this situation develops, boredom and isolation can kick in, so it's important to talk.

- Make a note of your own requirements. In the event that you may be isolated or in need of medical assistance, it is important that anyone intervening can understand your health situation. Write down any

allergies, medication requirements, underlying health conditions etc. and place them somewhere visible, or share with a neighbour or family member.

We are aware that some of the most vulnerable members of our community do not have access to social media, so please spread the word where possible.
