

VACANCY Parish Ranger (Full-time)

Due to increased workloads, Barton-le-Clay Parish Council is seeking a hardworking and self-motivated person to assist in the practical management of Barton-le-Clay's open spaces, facilities and premises.

The Parish Ranger will be required to work alongside the Grounds Maintenance Person, to undertake a wide range of duties keeping recreation, burial and playgrounds in top condition and to support their operation.

Candidates must demonstrate competence in grounds and property maintenance, most likely having some experience within the horticultural and/or building trades, although training will be provided, as necessary. Flexibility, reliability and commitment to quality work are vital, as is the ability to work on own initiative.

As a representative of the Parish Council, it is essential that the jobholder demonstrates good communication skills and the ability to project a positive image through interactions with residents, suppliers and users of Council facilities.

The candidate must be resilient, physically fit and happy working outdoors. A full UK driving licence and own transport is essential. Tools and uniform will be provided.

In order to respond to occasional emergencies, candidates are required to reside within approximately 10 miles of Barton-le-Clay.

Hours of Work: The hours of work will be 37 hours per week, including weekend working, to cover operational needs and the football season at the Sports Field Pavilion.

Pay: Starting from £13.26 per hour, depending on experience, payable monthly. There is potential for salary progression with gained experience and evidence of good performance.

(Salary range: £25,584pa to £27,711pa)

Business mileage and a mobile phone allowance is payable, in addition to salary.

The successful applicant will be offered enrolment in the Council's Pension Scheme and will have access to the Employee Assistance Programme.
