Flower Arranging Class 90: 'Holiday Memories'.

Flower Arranging Class 91: 'Take 7'- only 7 flowers (includes buds) maximum size 12"x12".

Flower Arranging Class 92: 'Green & White' maximum size 9"x9"x9".
