We would further request guidance on the possible historic stud wall which is proposed to be removed/altered.

OBJECT: The description does not appear to fit the submitted plans. The Parish Council has sought clarification from the planning officer and is awaiting reply

OBJECT to the conversion of one house to two dwellings. There are insufficient parking spaces for the dwellings outside of the conservation area.
